Cognitive test - patient information and instructions.

The brain is complex. It monitors the state of the body and its environment, controls the body's motion and also performs many of the higher level cognitive functions that allow us to think, plan, and accomplish the tasks in our daily lives. Cognitive functions are the basis for our activities of daily living and include the ability to shop, talk on the telephone, manage finances, drive, as well as to learn something new.

Cognitive test follow the neuropsychological tradition by measuring:

- Memory
- Executive Function
- Attention
- Visual Spatial
- Verbal Function
- Problem Solving
- Working Memory

How to prepare for the test?

Cognitive testing is very user-friendly and requires little orientation. Although the testing is performed on a computer, it does not require the patient to know how to use one. Testing times typically range from **45-60 minutes**, depending on the patient's age.

Please remember to bring any corrective lenses you may need to the appointment.

Other persons such as family, children, spouse etc. will not be permitted in the room for the testing.
